ELIGIBILITY: Open to any individual member of the National Rifle Association. **Ohio residents must be members of the Ohio Rifle and Pistol Association and must present membership cards.** Residents of other states may present their home State Association membership card in lieu of joining the Ohio Rifle and Pistol Association. ORPA membership is \$25.00 per year and may be paid at the registration desk.

Should there be fewer than five competitors in a class they will be moved to the next higher class. Fewer than four (4) High Masters will compete for open awards only. Awards will be sent with the results bulletin.

MATCH
CONDITIONS:

Competitors will pass their score card to the right, and score the target to their left. Competitors will be required to change their own targets. Use of the plug type scoring gauge will be restricted to range personnel. **Scorers and competitors** will “**Sign**” and turn in their score cards at the end of each caliber fired. A challenge fee of \$2.00 will be charged for each challenge made. NRA rules will govern all challenges.

FACILITIES:

There will be food, soft drinks, water and restrooms available. Camping will be available. There are restrooms, but no shower facilities.
