New for 2026: Shotmarker electronic targets will be used instead of paper targets. Please bring your own wi-fi enabled tablet or device for use.

Eligibility: Open to all eligible participants. Competitors need not be a member of the NRA or a CMP affiliated club to participate. Competitors must sign the MRPC and CMP affidavit and liability agreement forms and turn in to the Match Director at time of squadding:

Times and Dates:

- **Sunday, March 29, 2026**
- **Saturday, May 30, 2026**
- **Saturday, Sep 26, 2026**
- **Sunday, Nov 29, 2026**
- Signup and squadding opens at **8:00 am**
- Registration closes at **8:45 am**
- Firing begins at **9:00 am**
- The match is usually complete around 2:00 pm, but may extend later if required.

Entry Fee:

MRPC members: \$15

Non-MRPC members: \$20

Entries: Capacity is limited to 40 shooters on a first come first serve basis.

Course of Fire: This match will follow the CMP Mid-Range 3x600 course as defined in the 2026 CMP Highpower Rifle Competition Rules paragraphs 6.12, 6.13, 6.14, and Table 8:

Stage	Distance	Target	Sighting Shots	Record Shots	Time Limit (Block)
1	600 yards	MR / MR-1FC	Unlimited	20	25 min
2	600 yards	MR / MR-1FC	2	20	25 min
3	600 yards	MR / MR-1FC	2	20	25 min

Block Time: 3 minute preparation and 22 minute firing times will be combined into a 25 minute block time for each stage.

Sighting Shots: Sighting shots must be fired at the beginning of each event or stage and may be fired only before the first shot for record. No sighting shots may be fired after the first record shot. Unlimited sighting shots will be permitted in the first stage and two sighting shots before the second and third stages. **New for 2026: The two sighters on stages 2 and 3 are convertible.**

Firearms and Ammunition: Per the 2026 CMP Highpower Rifle Competition Rules, there will be categories for:

- **Service Rifle** (Rule 5.1.1-5.1.4)
- **Match Rifle** (Rule 5.1.5)
- **F-TR Rifle** (Rule 5.1.7)
- **F-Open Rifle** (Rule 5.1.8)
- **AR-Tactical Rifle** (Rule 5.1.9)
- **Palma Rifle** (ICFRA Rule T2)

No armor piercing, tracer, or calibers larger than .35 cal are allowed.

Projectiles must remain supersonic at the target to be registered by the Shotmarker system. Any other safe ammunition is permitted.

Competition Conditions:

- **Service, Match, and Palma Rifle:** Prone position with sling (Rule 6.1.3).

- **F-class and AR-Tactical:** Competitors may fire in a supported prone position with their rifle supported by a bipod / front rest and rear rest as defined by Rule 6.1.4 or they may fire in a prone position with a sling as defined by Rule 6.1.3.

Scoring: All competitors are required to act as scorekeepers alternate provisions have been made
