- Sunday, Nov 3, 2024
- Signup and squadding opens at 8:00 am
- Pits are sealed at 8:45 am
- Firing begins at 9:00 am
- Match is usually complete around 2:00 pm, but may extend later if required.

Entry Fee:

MRPC members: \$20

Non-MRPC members: \$25

Entries: Capacity is limited to 48 shooters on a first come first serve basis.

Course of Fire: This match will follow the CMP Mid-Range 3x600 course as defined in the 2024 CMP Highpower Rifle Competition Rules paragraphs 5.12, 5.13, 5.14, and Table 8:

Stage	Distance	Target	Sighting Shots	Record Shots	Time Limit (Block)
1	600 yards	MR / MR-1FC	Unlimited	20	25 min
2	600 yards	MR / MR-1FC	2	20	25 min
3	600 yards	MR / MR-1FC	2	20	25 min

Block Time: 3 minute preparation and 22 minute firing times will be combined into a 25 minute block time for each stage.

Sighting Shots: Sighting shots must be fired at the beginning of each event or stage and may be fired only before the first shot for record. No sighting shots may be fired after the first record shot. Unlimited sighting shots will be permitted in the first stage and two sighting shots before the second and third stages. A competitor may elect not to fire one or both sighting shots by informing their scorer that the next shot will be a record shot.

Firearms and Ammunition: Per the 2024 CMP Highpower Rifle Competition Rules, there will be categories for:

- **Service Rifle** (Rule 4.1.1-4.1.4)
- Match Rifle (Rule 4.1.5)
- **F-TR Rifle** (Rule 4.1.7)
- F-Open Rifle (Rule 4.1.8)
- AR-Tactical Rifle (Rule 4.1.9)
- Palma Rifle (Rule 5.14a, ICFRA Rule T2)

No armor piercing, tracer, or calibers larger than .35 cal are allowed. Any other safe ammunition is permitted.

Competition Conditions:

- Service, Match, and Palma Rifle: Prone position with sling (Rule 5.1.3).
- F-class and AR-Tactical: Competitors may fire in a supported prone position with their rifle supported by a bipod / front rest and rear rest as defined by Rule 5.1.4 or they may fire in a prone position with a sling as defined by Rule 5.1.3.

Scoring: All competitors are required to act as scorekeepers and target markers unless alternate provisions have been made
